in my quality as the General Director of the Research Centre for the Humanities of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences hereby I would like to confirm the willingness of our Research Centre to act as the main local organizer of the 21st CIEPO Symposium to be held in Budapest in 2014, in cooperation with the Department of Turkish Studies, Oriental Institute, Loránd Eötvös University (Director and Chair Prof. Dr. Géza Dávid), and the Research Group of Ottoman Studies, Department of Medieval and Early Modern Hungarian History, University of Szeged (associate professor Sándor Papp).

We suggest 7 to 11 October as the date of the symposium. In accordance with our previous exchanges

---we would like to restrict the number of participants to 180

---selection of the active participants will be the task of a Vetting Board

---the members of the Vetting Board will be members of the CIEPO Governing Directorate, their names will be withheld

---the Vetting Board will make its decisions on the basis of anonymous abstracts by a double blind system

---in course of the selection workshops and panels are preferred to individual contributions

---among workshops and panels preference is given to international panels and workshops with participants from more than one country

---we can offer proper meeting venues (both larger and smaller meeting halls), catering and accommodation.

We understand that participants pay for their own travel, meals and accommodation and are expected to pay a participation fee that will not exceed 100 euros.

We are ready to take care of the administration of the applications; my colleagues who will be in charge of day-to-day administration of the preparations are Mónika F. Molnár (molnar.monika@btk.mta.hu) and Gábor Fodor (fodor.gabor@btk.mta.hu).

We are very much looking forward to this major international scholarly event that will definitely help communication in our research field.
