2026 CIÉPO Article Prize



The Comité International des Études Pré-ottomanes et Ottomanes is pleased to announce a call for submissions to the 2026 CIÉPO Article Prize. This prize will be awarded for the best original article in the fields of pre-Ottoman and/or Ottoman studies, written and published by a young scholar. The prize is awarded once every two years and carries a cash prize of €1,000.

Articles submitted for consideration for the 2026 Prize must have been published in a scholarly journal or collected volume of articles **between 1 October 2022 and 30 September 2025**, and have been published within 3 years of receiving the PhD. Articles "in press" may be submitted in page proof form accompanied by a letter of acceptance from the editor.

Submissions by multiple authors will be accepted as long as all authors meet the submission requirements.

The prize will be awarded at the 26th CIÉPO Symposium in Varna, Bulgaria (23-27 June 2026). The first article prize was awarded at the 21st CIÉPO Symposium, held in Budapest on 7-11 October 2014. The article prize will be awarded for the fifth time under the present call.

All materials are to be submitted electronically, sent as email attachments, to Professor Claudia Römer (claudia.roemer@univie.ac.at).

The deadline for submissions is 1 February 2026.

Submission requirements include:

- c a PDF copy of the article or the page proofs, including the title page and the Table of Contents of the journal/collected volume in which it was/is being published.
- c If the article is in proof form, a letter of acceptance from the editor of the journal/collected volume should also be submitted.
- c A current *curriculum vitae* of the author(s).
- c Articles must be in one of the official CIÉPO languages: English, French, German or Turkish.
